#### **CARE & MAINTANENCE**

Maintenance of hardwood floors depends on the applied finish. Flooring assumes daily cleaning from dust and grit using a vacuum, followed by a thorough cleaning with floor cleaner. Floor surface areas that receive the most traffic and get worn down quicker, such as areas by the front door, hallways, kitchens etc. should be periodically renewed.
